LA PARENTHÈSE DE LUMIÈRE

The Maxalto 2026 collection unfolds as a suspended interval, a rarefied pause that gently interrupts the narrative flow to reveal a new radiance. It is a fragment of light within the Ville Lumière for Maison & Objet 2026, a delicate moment of suspension in the evolution of the collection, marked by new designs and range extensions in which forms, materials and details emerge with renewed intensity. A light that is both metaphorical and tangible, illuminating the identity of the furnishings and finding resonance in the brilliance of the new sideboards, symbols of a moment of renewed optimism and refined design expression.



“For this new dining proposal, my focus was primarily on materials. The new Luminor storage units in PVD are compact volumes in yellow or rose gold, enclosed by a glass top: autonomous presences that do not seek camouflage, but instead engage in dialogue with any setting, whether classic or contemporary. The Kalystrus tables, crafted entirely in marble, share this same radical approach: tops supported by solid elements, like columns, that become fixed points in space, independent of the character of the surrounding interior.”

Luminor

Luminor

Luminor is a new collection of storage units that combines design rigour, precious materials and advanced technologies, giving rise to a family of elements with a strong architectural identity. The range comprises three types of units: one vertical version, 135 cm high and 95 cm wide, available with or without integrated lighting, and two horizontal versions offered in heights of 78 cm and 55 cm. The former is ideal as a service element in dialogue with the dining table, while the latter is designed for the living area and is perfectly proportioned to sit opposite a sofa. Both horizontal versions measure 220 cm in width.

Luminor

Luminor introduces the use of PVD - a technology already developed by Arclinea for its high-end kitchens - in yellow gold or rose gold finishes. The project is the result of the encounter between the technical expertise of Antonio Citterio, Art Director of both Maxalto and Arclinea, and the industrial know-how developed by Arclinea, coherently translated into the aesthetic and quality standards of Maxalto.

Luminor

PVD stands for Physical Vapor Deposition and is a finishing process, realized inside a closed and vacuumed space, where metals like titanium, zirconia or chrome are vaporized on a steel sheet to adhere on the surface in a durable way. This allows a long lasting, shiny and mirror like reflecting finishing. PVD offers a more durable and environmentally safe finishing as there is nearly no use of chemicals or material waste.

Maintenance:

Use a soft cloth: Microfiber is ideal to avoid scratches.

Mild cleaning solution: Use lukewarm water or a gentle, pH-neutral detergent.

Avoid harsh chemicals: Do not use abrasive cleaners, strong acids, bleach, or solvents like acetone.

Rinse and dry: After cleaning, rinse with clean water and gently dry with a soft cloth.


For stubborn dirt: Use isopropyl alcohol (IPA) diluted in water sparingly, then rinse thoroughly








Luminor

The Luminor volumes feature hinged doors and drawers. The interiors, conceived as refined cases, are finished in elegant taupe tones and equipped with internal fittings in maple fris , enhancing the sense of sophistication. The bronzed reflective painted glass top adds further refinement and harmonises with the knob handle, simple in form yet exquisitely detailed, also made of glass with the same finish as the top.



The structure is raised from the floor by a substantial 20 cm plinth, visually lightening the volume while lending a sculptural presence to the piece as a whole.



Kalustrus

The new Kalustrus table collection explores the theme of monumentality through pure geometries and materials of strong presence. At the heart of the project is the conical form, reinterpreted as a structural element capable of lending the tables a sculptural yet elegant character.

Name of Greek inspiration that mostly recalls the word Kalos = beautiful, from the Greek καλός, and the classical ideal of the “beautiful and good” “καλός κάγαθός” so used in Homeric poems and among philosophers.

The elliptical-top version, available in widths of 300 cm and 350 cm, seats 8-10 people and features two conical legs, a solution that enhances both stability and visual strength.

Alongside this is a circular version seating six, a new interpretation of the round table that adopts a single central cone as its base. Offered in one size with a diameter of 160 cm, it provides a convivial solution with balanced proportions. Both versions are available entirely in wood, in a range of finishes - brushed light oak, brushed black oak and wengé - as well as entirely in marble. Marble options include the new polished veined Arabescato, alongside polished white Calacatta and matt or polished black Marquinia, already part of the Maxalto collection.


A further option combines a wooden top with marble legs, expressing a measured balance between material richness and proportion, and establishing a strong architectural presence within the domestic space. In this configuration, the conical base is also available in natural travertine marble. The mineral presence of this element naturally complements the wooden finishes of the top, creating a harmonious contrast between warm surfaces and varied textures.

With this collection, Maxalto expands its formal repertoire, introducing a new language of assertive volumes and noble materials, interpreted through the design sensibility of Antonio Citterio.



Artemone

Artemone

The Artemone storage collection was introduced in 2024 from the desire to reinterpret the traditional dining cupboard once associated with the kitchen, transforming it into a contemporary service element dedicated to dining. Today, Antonio Citterio presents a new horizontal configuration with drawers, conceived as a natural extension of the family and designed to harmonise with the proportions of the current dining tables in the collection. Resting on an elegant die-cast aluminium base or in a new floor-standing version, the unit subtly references certain stylistic cues from the 1960s, reinterpreting the combination of hinged doors and a top drawer in an essential yet sophisticated form

Artemone, from the Greek *artémōn*, indicates an element that supports and controls the structure. The name evokes the idea of constructive balance and moderation, where form arises from the project function and clarity.

It is available in numerous configurations of doors, drawers and modules with or without flap doors, all of which can be fitted with internal shelves, pull-out trays and cutlery inserts, allowing for a personalised and functional organisation of space. The aluminium base, light in design and separated from the upper section by a narrow shadow gap of just a few millimetres, lends the structure an airy quality and softens the material contrast between metal and wood. The base finishes can be coordinated with the upper section, which is available in black, soya or red lacquer, or in wood finishes including grey oak, brushed light or black oak, and sawn white oak, a tone characterised by a highly tactile texture.

With these new configurations, Artemone further expands its identity, offering an elegant and functional storage unit that integrates seamlessly into contemporary dining environments.

Ares

To the existing design, Maxalto now introduces a new range extension, conceived to broaden the family with versions that express the same aesthetic identity through renewed proportions and more essential geometries. The bold structural presence of solid wood, with X-shaped legs created by the intersection of two overlapping profiles, is the defining feature of the Ares table, a piece that combines formal elegance with structural solidity.

Ares, from the Greek *Arēs*, recalls the idea of an original and concentrated force: primary energy that supports the form and guarantees its balance over time.

The tops of the new tables, offered in lengths of 300 cm and 350 cm, feature clean, lenticular lines and are paired with a wooden base that recalls the distinctive “false cross” of the original model, reinterpreted with an even purer language. The top can be finished to match the solid oak or wengé base, or alternatively in marble, for a more precious and materially expressive version.


The top is available in the new polished veined Arabescato marble finish, in addition to the polished white Calacatta and matt or polished black Marquinia marbles already present in the Maxalto collection, enhancing the table’s sculptural presence. This material choice accentuates the profile of the top and underscores the dialogue between the solidity of wood and the luminosity of marble, giving the Ares collection a renewed richness of interpretation.

With these new variants, Ares opens up to a wider range of interior scenarios, maintaining the iconic strength of its structure and reinforcing its role as a central element in the contemporary living space.
